Common Definitional Features

- An interactive computer-based and internet-connected learning environment;
- Students are separated from their teachers by time or location, or both;
- Certified teachers required; and
- Distinguishes between schools and courses, and full and part time options

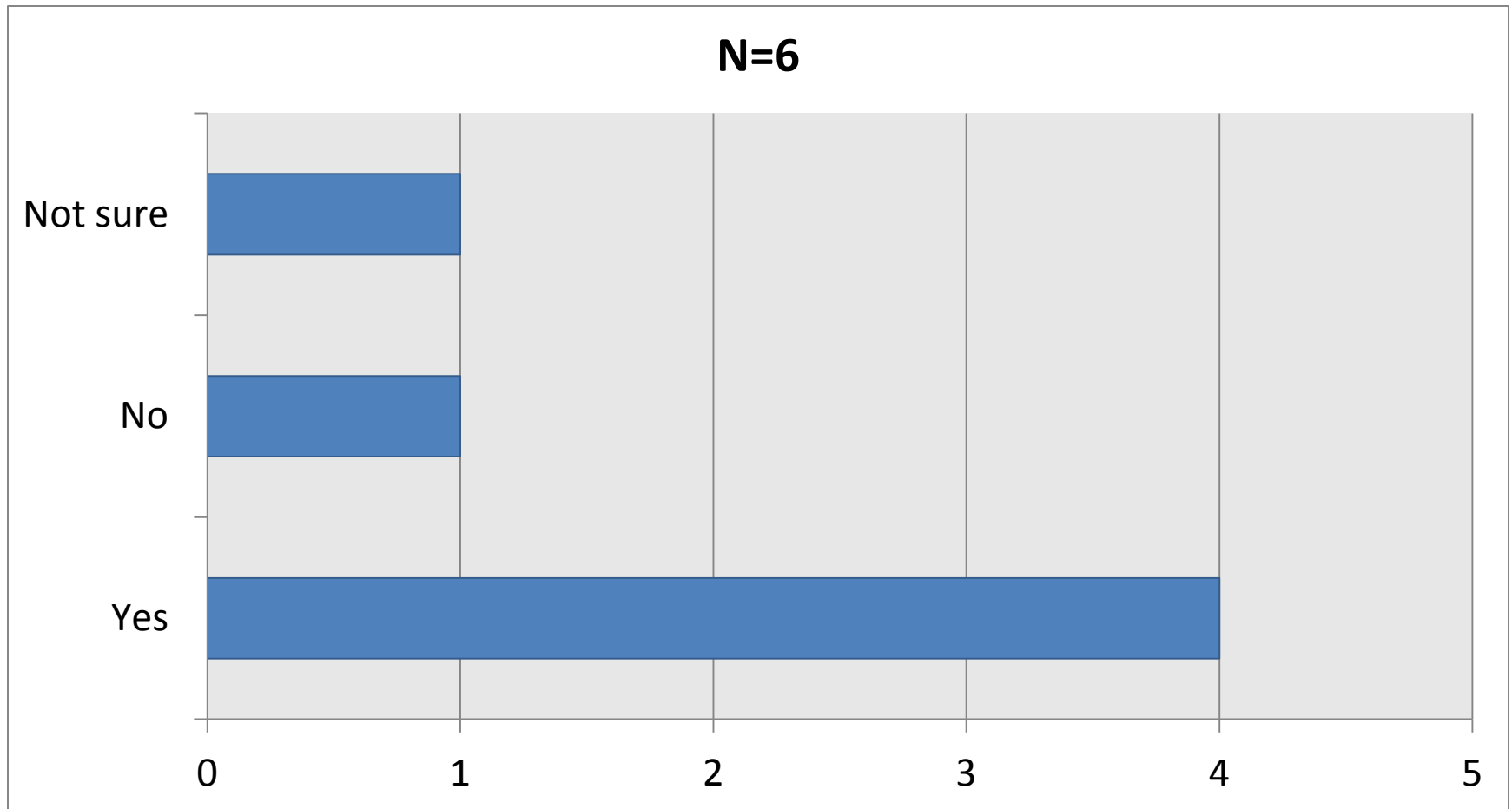
Preliminary Topics Identified in Policy Scan

- Reporting requirements

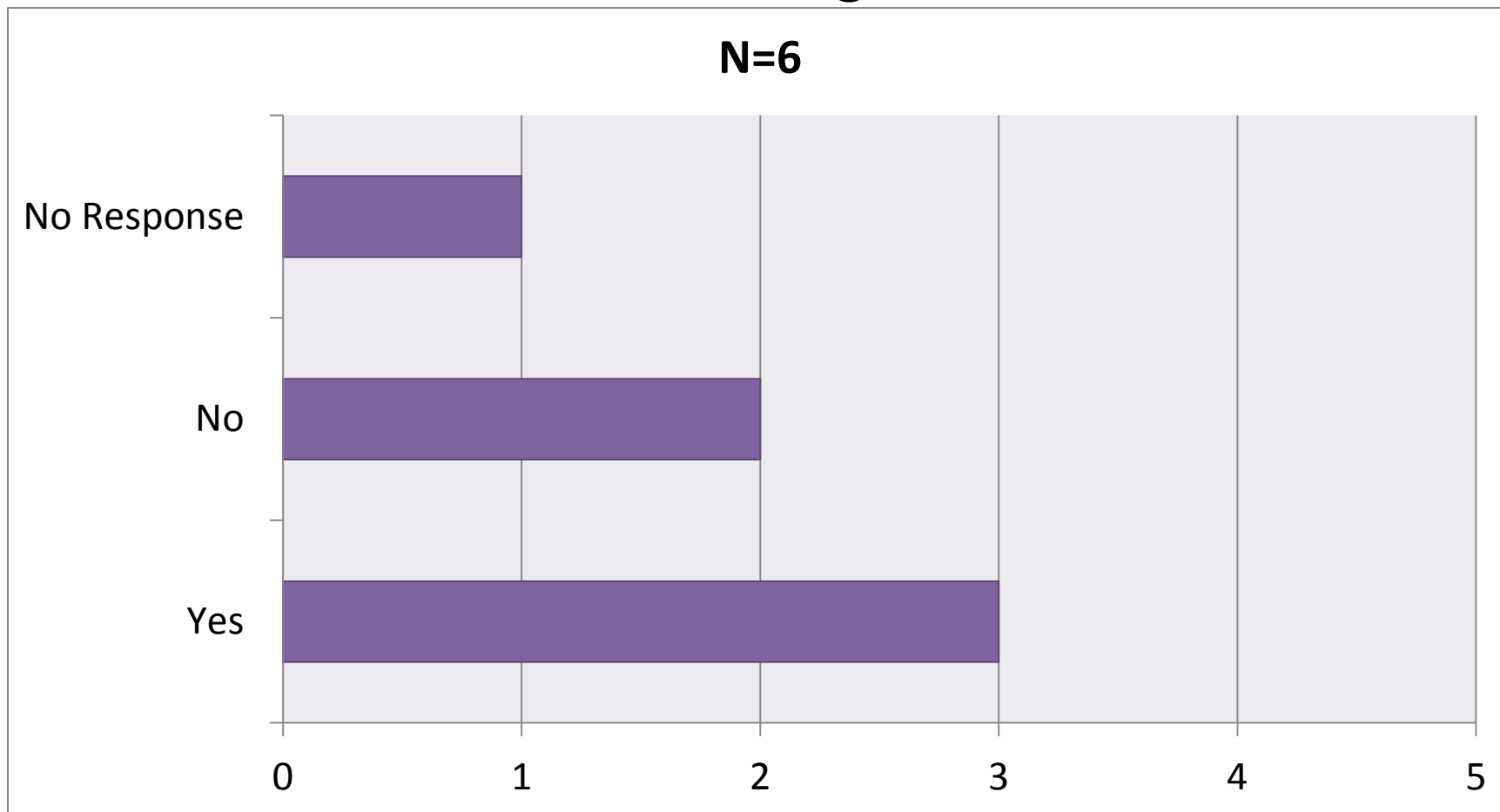

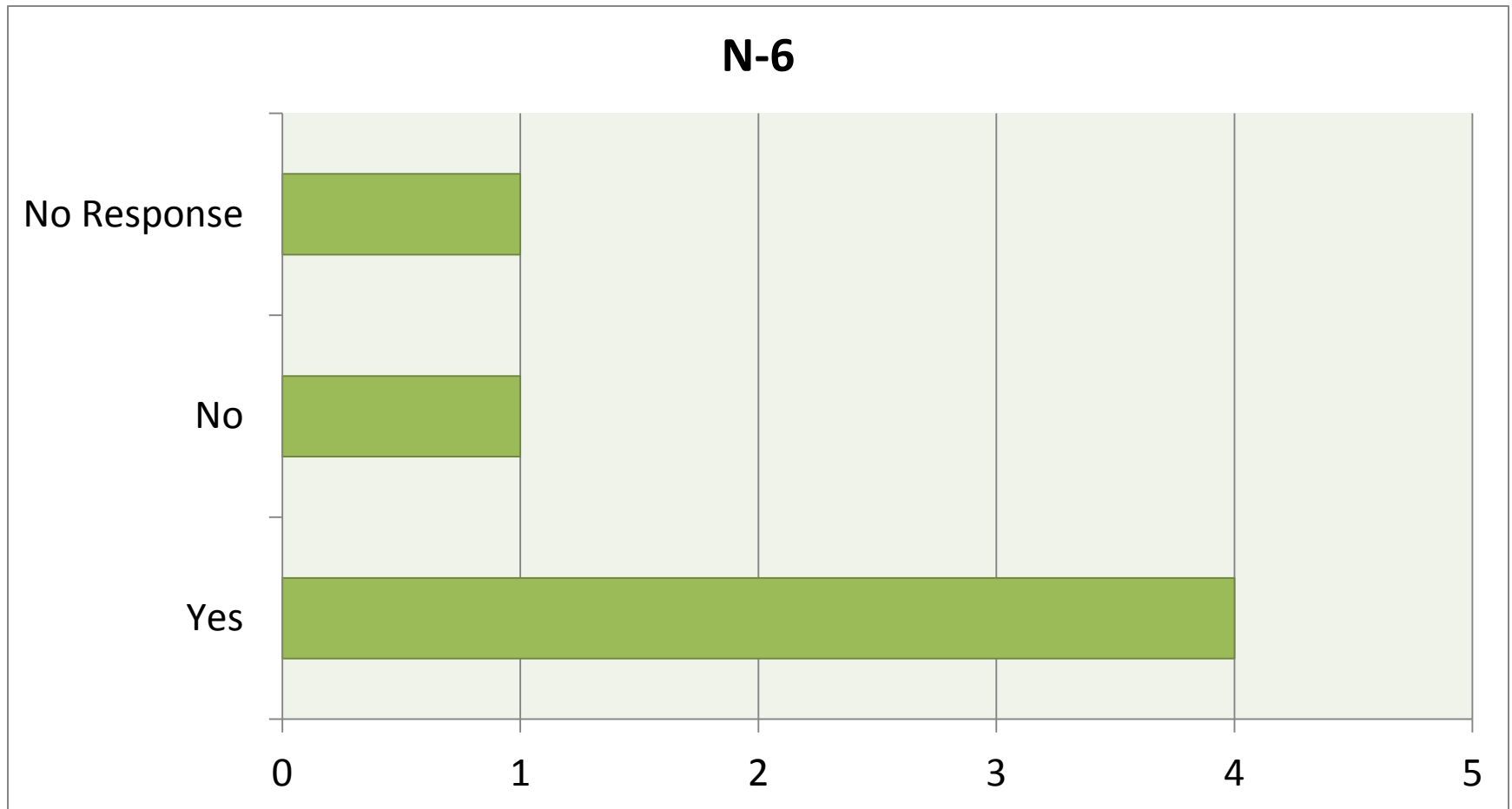

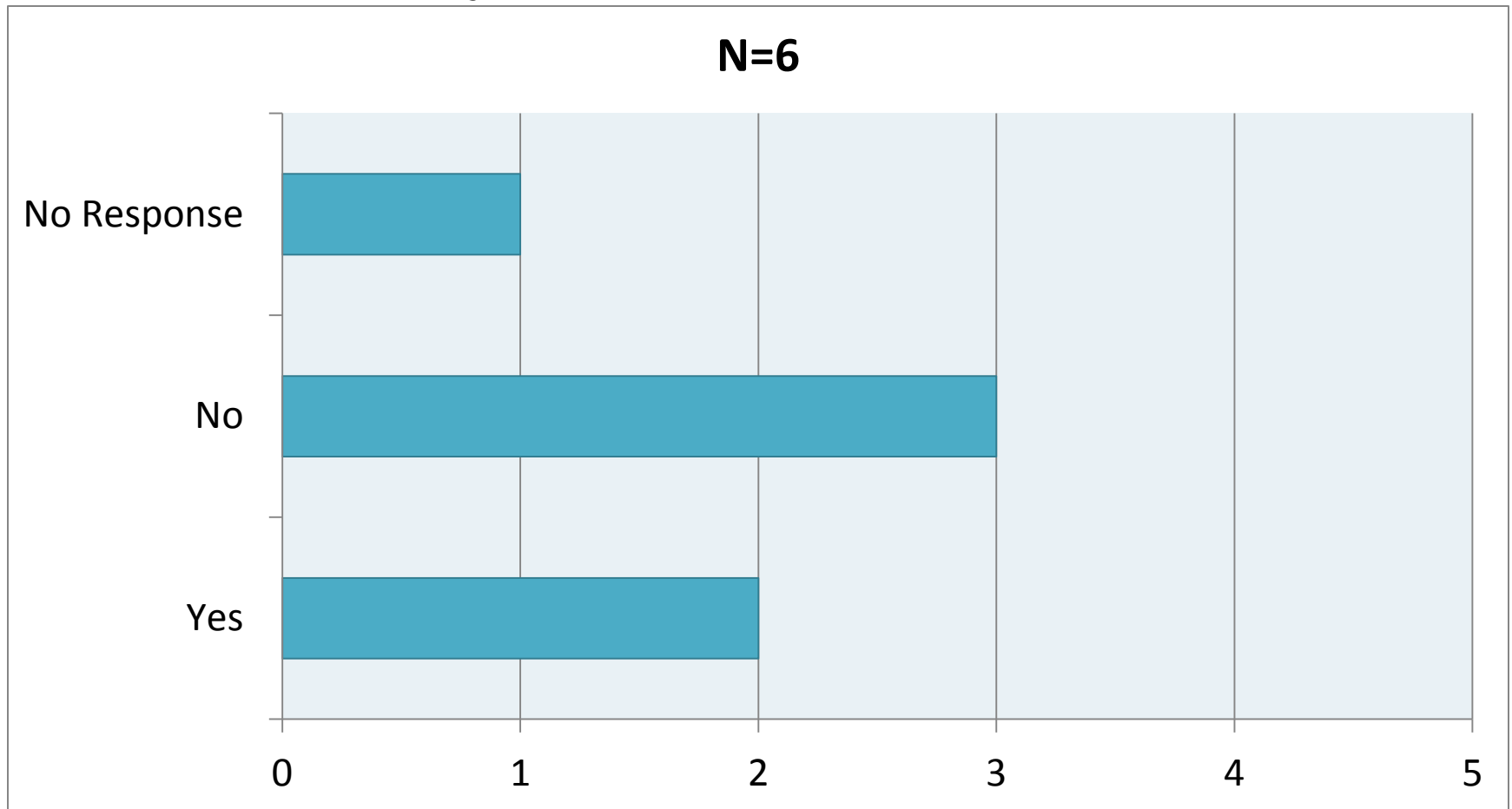
Does your state have guidance on collecting and reporting data on SWD in online learning?



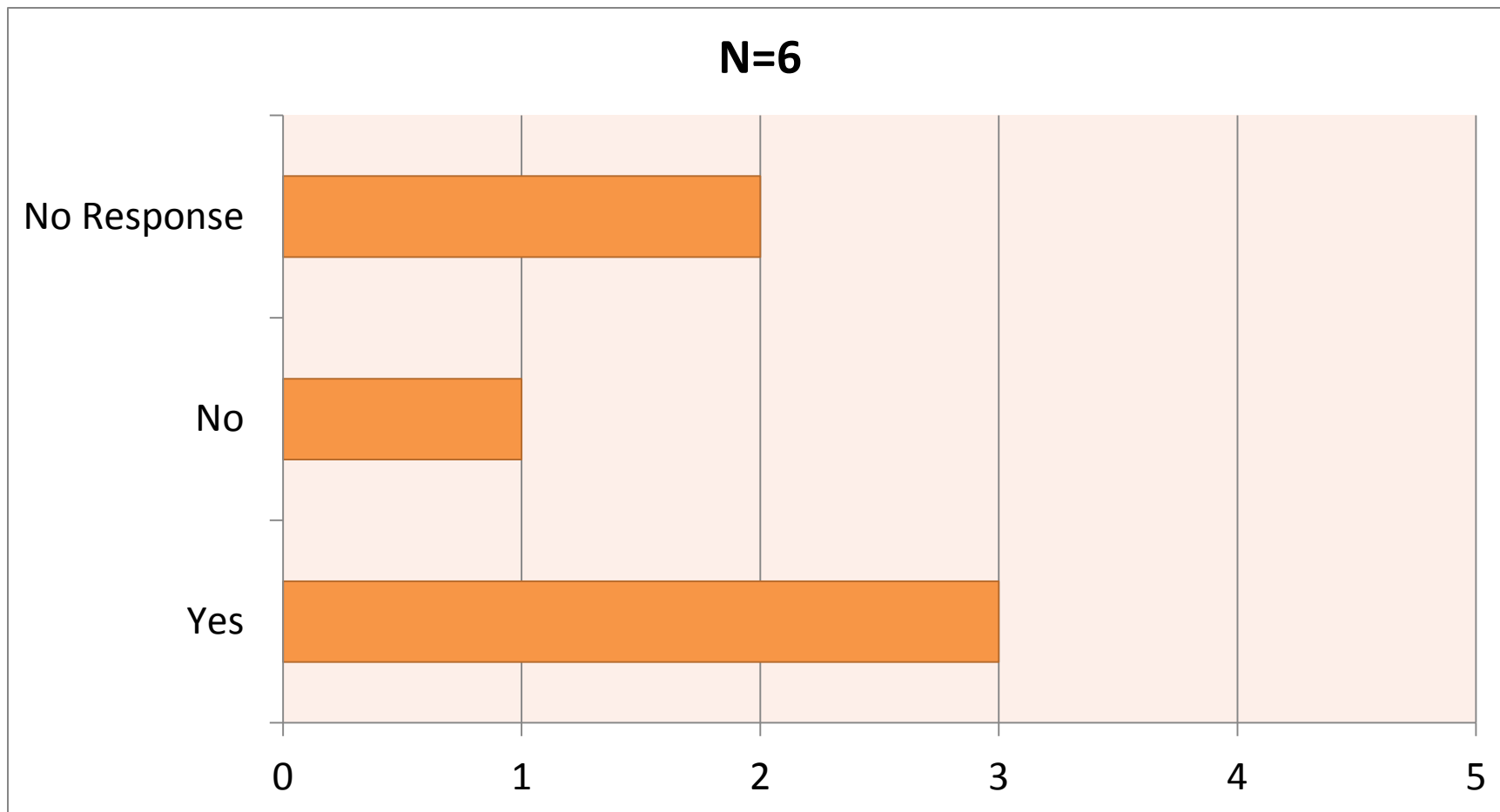
