

Data Reporting Requirements



- What are the required data elements?
- How are you collecting the data?
 - What is working?
 - How would you improve that collection?



MOE and CEIS Data Fiscal Reporting Requirements

- Total LEA/ESA allocations for Sections 611 and 619 funds
- School year's data used to make LEA/ESA determinations
- LEA/ESA determinations
- MOE reduction amount



MOE and CEIS Data Fiscal Reporting Requirements (cont.)

- Implementation of CEIS due to significant disproportionality based on race or ethnicity is occurring with respect to the:
 - identification of children as children with disabilities, including, identification of children with particular disabilities;
 - placement of children in particular educational environments; and
 - incidence, duration, and type of disciplinary actions, including suspensions/expulsions.



MOE and CEIS Data Fiscal Reporting Requirements (cont.)

- Amount required to reserve for CEIS due to identification of significant disproportionality
- Whether an LEA/Education Service Agency (ESA) voluntarily reserved funds for CEIS and
- Amount reserved for voluntarily implementing CEIS.



MOE and CEIS Data Student Reporting Requirements

- The number of children who received CEIS during the reference school year and
- The number of children who received CEIS at any time in the two preceding school years and received special education and related services during the reference school year





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New Data Elements

- LEA MOE
 - Did the state determine whether the LEA/ESA met the MOE compliance standard in (Reference Year)?
 - Did the LEA/ESA meet the MOE compliance standard in (Reference Year)?
 - By the date of this data submission, did the state return nonfederal funds to the Department based on the failure of the LEA/ESA to meet the MOE compliance standard in (Reference Year)?
 - What amount of non-federal funds did the state return to the Department based on the failure of the LEA/ESA to meet the MOE compliance standard in (Reference Year)?

Data Quality Considerations



- How confident are you in the quality of the data?
- How are you validating the data?
 - What is working?
 - How could you improve?



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How Do You Know if LEAs/ESAs Reduced MOE Correctly?

- If LEAs/ESAs
 - received a federal IDEA 611 allocation for the current Federal Fiscal Year
 - had an increase in federal IDEA 611 allocations
 - had a "meets requirements" determination
 - were not required to reserve CEIS funds
 - established and maintained programs of free appropriate public education (FAPE) that meet the requirements of Section 613(a)
 - reduced MOE by up to 50 percent of the increase

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How Do You Know If LEAs/ESAs Correctly Reserved Funds for CEIS?

- LEAs/ESAs
 - reserved <u>only</u> 15 percent of funds for required CEIS
 - reserved up to 15 percent for voluntary CEIS
 - only reserved funds for required CEIS <u>or</u> voluntary CEIS
 - received a federal IDEA 611 and/or 619 allocation




