- Continue to differentiate but incorporate some consistent protocols that will be used with every State.



DIFFERENTIATED MONITORING AND SUPPORTS (DMS)

- INCREASE TRANSPARENCY.
- CONDUCT ON-SITE VISIT TO BOTH PART B AND C PROGRAMS FOR A SELECTED STATE.
- PLACE GREATER EMPHASIS ON GENERAL SUPERVISION.
