618 Data Collection and Submission Timeline

The 618 Data Collection and Submission Timeline shows how different IDEA data collections span across years. Throughout a given school year, data stewards may be working with three different years of data concurrently (see table 1).

- 1. States collect and report Child Count and Educational Environments data during the same school year.
- 2. States report **Discipline, Exiting, Dispute Resolution**, and **Personnel** data in November of the school year following the school year during which they collected the data. States report **Assessment** data in December of the school year following the school year during which they collected the data.
- 3. **MOE and CEIS** data that states submit in May of each year include fiscal and student data for multiple school years.
